EXTRA-ORDINARY

No.63/5, - TUESDAY, JUNE 12, 1973

09. Every proprietor and every editor of a newspaper shall, with in fourteen days of the date of the coming into operation of these regulations and every person who becomes a proprietor or editor of a newspaper after the said date, shall within fourteen days after he becomes such proprietor or editor, make separate applications to the Council for registration of their names as proprietor or editor as the case may be. Every such application shall be renewed on or before the thirty-first day of January in each subsequent year.
10. Every application under regulation 9 shall state the full name of the proprietor and Editor and the name of the newspaper and shall further contain the registered address of the newspaper and the private address of the proprietor and editor.

**Sri Lanka Press Council Law,
No.5 of 1973 of The National State Assembly.**

Section 26

For the purposes of this Law, the printer and publisher of every newspaper shall, on each day on which such newspaper is published or in the day next following which is not a holiday, cause to be delivered at the office of the Commissioner a copy of such newspaper and of every subsequent and other varied edition or impression of such newspaper so printed or published with the name and place of residence of the printer or publisher thereof signed and written thereon, after such name and address are printed by his hand and in his accustomed manner of signing or by some person appointed and authorised by him for that purpose, and of whose appointment and authority due notice in writing signed by such printer or publisher is given to the Commissioner.
